Like other 2017 souvenirs, the pin exhibits the famous Sandwich Fair windmill with a stylish silhouette. Decorated with gold stars around the edge, the sleek design glitters. Its bicolor pattern is eye-catching and sophisticated. The metallic writing arched over the windmill spells the words “Celebrating our 130<sup>th</sup> Fair 2017.” Spanning the bottom of the pin, the words “Sandwich Fair” shine in capital letters.
