


Farm Animal Puzzle

 - Cattle can smell odors up to 6 miles away.








All About DAIRY CATTLE

- A Jersey cow's milk is creamer and used in ice cream.



All About GOATS

All About SHEEP

- Female sheep are called ewes. Male sheep are called rams. Baby sheep are called lambs.

Fun Facts About the 2024 Sandwich Fair Pin Design

The two metal signs that surrounded the gates at the original ticket office are used as the featured logo of the 2024 Sandwich Fair. Similar structures grace the main entrance from Pratt Road.

It appears they were installed in the late 1930s/early 1940s when a new double gate and graveled drive was installed. This was to admit a double line of traffic during the rush periods and allow two-way traffic at other times.

They were moved further west with the ticket office in 1978 and moved again in 2024 to accompany the renovated ticket office to the northeast part of the fair.
